

Management of contagion caused by COVID-19 Vademecum for the University College “Cristo Re”

“The University Residences intend to ensure hospitality in order to continue contributing to the growth of the person and the development of transversal skills by taking appropriate security measures”.

INFORMATION FOR GUESTS

Each member of the community must know and apply the rules and the correct behaviour described below, working to ensure the health and safety of themselves and of all other members.

The entire community present in the Residence and anyone who enters the facility is informed about the provisions in force through ad hoc communications and the posting of information leaflets.

PERSONAL HYGIENE PRECAUTIONS

Daily cleaning and regular sanitation of rooms, common areas and leisure areas are ensured. Each student is required to contribute to the maintenance of cleanliness and sanitation. Guests are warmly invited to respect the hygiene of their room with particular attention and frequency.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

In case of changes in the epidemiological framework, in compliance with the provisions of the current rules and the indications of the World Health Organization, may be requested use of surgical masks or FFP2, spacer of at least 1 meter (where logistical and structural conditions permit) and precautions at times at risk of aggregation.

USE OF COMMON AREAS

For the use of dining rooms, study room, laundry and other common areas it is necessary to maintain interpersonal spacing. The use of the mask is recommended and may be required in indoor environments, in the event that it is not possible to maintain safe distances.

Each student is required to contribute to keeping spaces and furniture (e.g. tables, chairs, etc.) clean, especially when using them. The availability of products for sanitizing hands and the surfaces used is guaranteed.

In the use of the shared kitchen, since it is not possible to respect the personal distance and to avoid contamination of food and dishes, **IT IS NECESSARY TO WEAR THE MASK.**

In the kitchen each student is responsible for hygiene, proper food storage and careful cleaning of the dishes and utensils used.

In the kitchen and in the dining rooms, cleaning and sanitizing service is enhanced and there are tools available to everyone (e.g. detergent for cookers, sinks and tables etc.).

Before and after the use of the vending machines, it is compulsory to disinfect one's hands with the appropriate hydro-alcoholic solutions present in the premises. The daily cleanliness of the keypads of the beverage and snack vending machines is guaranteed with special detergents.

ACCESS AND RESPONSIBLE STAY IN THE FACILITY

Each student, resident outside the Veneto Region, is suggested to choose her own temporary doctor from the Azienda Ulss 6 Euganea's list of doctors for off-side students.

The student guests of the structure adopt responsible behavior both inside and outside for the protection of their own health and that of other people present in the facility.

They undertake to monitor their state of health and to communicate promptly to the Management any contact with positive subjects and/ or the onset of symptoms attributable to infection with COVID-19.

In case of risk of contagion (temperature above 37,5°C, onset of symptoms or contact with positive subjects) each student undertakes to give urgent communication to the Management and to use the greatest caution, respecting the distance and using FFP2 mask, for the time necessary to ascertain their clinical situation.

MANAGEMENT OF A POSITIVE PERSON IN THE FACILITY

In case of positivity it is necessary to:

- Communicate immediately with the Management and state whether it is considered appropriate to leave the facility or agree on the management of the necessary isolation period.
- Stay isolated within your own room. The guest will make immediate contact with the health facilities in charge or with his primary physician, so that she can receive information on self-isolation in quarantine, any treatment to be followed and the need to alert the competent health authorities.
- Identify by the person who has been found positive at COVID-19 any "close contacts" in order to allow people to take the necessary security measures.

EXTERNAL VISITORS ENTRY TO THE FACILITY

Access to external visitors, whether they are family, friends or acquaintances, is to be considered excluded unless justified request and prior authorization by the Management.

If they are allowed, they will have to comply with all the rules provided for domestic guests; the student is co-responsible for the behavior adopted by those who enter the structure to visit her and will have to monitor compliance with the rules. The use of the mask is recommended in indoor common areas and especially in case of interviews.

At the entrance to the structure for external visitors will be mandatory:

- go to the limited and defined areas near the entrance, used for this sole purpose and that will be sanitized daily. It is forbidden to go to any other room of the facility.
- use dedicated toilets, which will be sanitized daily. It is strictly forbidden to use the toilets intended for guest students.

SUPPLIERS AND EXTERNAL PERSONNEL ENTRY TO THE FACILITY

For the access of suppliers and external personnel, entry, transit and exit procedures are identified, using predefined modes, routes and timing. If possible, the drivers of the means of transport must remain on board their vehicles and, for the necessary loading and unloading activities, the carrier must adhere to the strict interpersonal distance of 1 meter.

Suppliers and external personnel, compatibly with the tasks entrusted to them, are only allowed access to limited areas of the facility. For access to the rooms of the residence it is recommended to use the mask.

Toilet facilities dedicated to them must be identified and ensured adequate daily cleaning, as it is absolutely forbidden to use those intended for students.

ORGANIZATION OF MEETINGS/EVENTS

Within the facility events and face-to-face meetings are managed according to the current regulations for the containment of the contagion from COVID-19 and are organized according to the required safety procedures.

COMMITMENT TO COMPLY WITH SAFETY PROCEDURES

In occasion of the signature of the contract will be demanded the subscription from the student of the commitment to fully comply with the rules contained in this *Vademecum – Management of contagion caused by COVID-19*.

These rules are to be considered complementary and, where of greater guarantee than the current health situation, substitutes with respect to our Regulation.
